Answering the Call/ Making a Difference

Published and distributed over 5,000 copies of these guides about getting involved in strengthening marriages and families, with suggestions ranging from simple volunteer involvement to possible paid careers. Answering the Call was commissioned by BYU's School of Family Life. Making a Difference targets a broader audience and is currently being used to train educators at the university level.



Family Outreach Conference

Established the first ever Family Outreach Conference at Brigham Young University with over 350 students, alumni, and community professionals in attendance. National and local experts shared their expertise and breakout sessions allowed participants to take home practical ideas and convert their learning into a plan to reach out.
